Public Works Reminders

Snowmobiles/ATV's

Snowmobiles and ATV's are not permitted to be used within the Town of Langham limits, this includes public parks. You must use the most direct route to and from home to reach the outside of town limits. You can not drive on private property.

Snow Removal

The Public works department would like to remind residents that in the event of a major snow fall please remove vehicles from the street in order for the crew to be able to adequately plow the roads.

Please refrain from piling/pushing/blowing snow on our roadways and parking areas. Putting snow on our roadways is a risk to motorized vehicles as well as pedestrians.

Please pull your garbage and recycle carts back onto your property as soon as possible on pick up days. Snow removal becomes nearly impossible to complete when the carts are left on the street.

Please watch for the "Tow Away Zone" signs. These orange signs will be on yellow sandwich boards and placed on streets that will be scheduled to have snow removed from the curb.

All dogs and cats in the Town of Langham are required to be licensed. Licenses are \$45 for the lifetime of the animal. There is a \$5 replacement charge for a lost tag.
