TRAFFIC BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LANGHAM TO AMEND TRAFFIC BYLAW NO. 2010-10 KNOWN AS THE TOWN OF LANGHAM TRAFFIC BYLAW

THE COUNCIL of the Town of Langham in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) Part V, Section 42; is repealed and the following substituted therefore:

Obstructions

(1) No person shall place or leave any electrical cord, lumber, tree branches, or any other thing whatsoever across any lane, sidewalk, or street in such a manner that it blocks, obstructs or impedes pedestrian or vehicular traffic, or renders said lanes, sidewalk or street unsafe for passage by pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

(2) Electrical cords may be allowed to cross a sidewalk provided the cord is suspended from a riser of a minimum height of three (3) meters above the sidewalk.

- 2) Part IX; is repealed and the following substituted therefore:

PART IX – PENALTIES

66. GENERAL

Any person convicted of a breach of the provisions of this bylaw shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting provincial magistrate or justice of the peace having jurisdiction a penalty of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$150.00 exclusive of costs and upon default of payment thereof the person convicted may be committed to a correctional institution for any time determined by the said provincial magistrate or justice of the peace not exceeding 30 days unless the penalty and costs including the costs of committal and of the conveyance of the person convicted to the said correctional institution are sooner paid.

67. EXCESSIVE ACCELERATION

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 56 to the contrary, any person convicted of an offence under Section 39 of this Bylaw shall forfeit and pay a fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$150.00, exclusive of costs.

68. VOLUNTARY PAYMENT \$150.00

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 56 to the contrary, any person who has committed or is alleged to have committed an offense under the following sections of this bylaw may pay a voluntary penalty of \$150.00:

71. VOLUNTARY PAYMENT \$150.00

72. VOLUNTARY PAYMENT \$150.00

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 56 to the contrary, any person who has committed or is alleged to have committed an offense under the following sections of this bylaw may pay a voluntary penalty of \$150.00:

provided however that if the payment is made within ten (10) days of the service of the ticket or notice, the penalty will be reduced to \$50.00.

75. COMING INTO FORCE

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the day it is approved by the Highway Traffic Board.
