

**TOWN OF LANGHAM  
BYLAW 2014-11**

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A FEE FOR APPEALING PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS

---

**THE COUNCIL** of the Town of Langham, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) Any person who appeals an Assessment pursuant to Section 224(1) of “*The Municipality Act, 2006*” shall pay the Municipality the sum of \$200.00 in respect to each Assessment being appealed.
  
- 2) The fee shall be paid at the time of filing the Notice of Appeal, or at any other time within the 30 day period mentioned in Section 226(1) or in a re-evaluation year within the 60 day period mentioned in Section 226 (1.1) of “*The Municipalities Act, 2006.*”
  
- 3) If an appellant is successful, in whole or in part, on an assessment or classification appeal, Council shall refund any fee that was submitted by the appellant to the Municipality.
  
- 4) Bylaw number 3-1997 is hereby repealed.
