

BYLAW NO. 5-84

TOWN OF LANGHAM

A BYLAW WITH RESPECT TO LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY.

The Council of the Town of Langham in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows;

1. No person shall herd any cattle at any time within the limits of the Town of Langham.
2. No person shall graze cattle nor shall any cattle be permitted to graze at any time within the limits of the Town of Langham.
3. No person shall keep any horses, cattle, sheep or any other livestock, poultry, pigeons, foxes, mink, rabbits or any other animal reared for fur bearing within the limits of the Town of Langham.
4. This Bylaw shall take effect with the passing thereof. Keepers of livestock at the date of passing this Bylaw are hereby exempt from the provisions of this Bylaw until the first day of October, 1985.
5. Any person found guilty of any offence of this Bylaw shall be subject to a fine of One hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the first offence, Two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for the second offence and Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the third or any subsequent offence.
6. Bylaw No. 364, passed by Council the 8th day of April, 1958, Bylaw No. 389, passed by Council the 2nd day of October, 1961, and Bylaw No. 395, passed by Council the 5th day of November, 1962, are hereby repealed.
