TOWN OF LANGHAM

BYLAW NO. 2-92

A Bylaw of the Town of Langham to control the operation of snowmobiles within the town limits.

The Council of the Town of Langham, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Subject to the provisions of The Snowmobile Act and Section 2 and Section 3 and Section 4 of this Bylaw a snowmobile operator may utilize any street, avenue or lane within the Town of Langham being the most direct route from the operator's residence to the Town limits.
- It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on Main Street East for the purpose of crossing Main Street East only at the following intersections;

Main Street East and Second Avenue

Main Street East and Third Avenue

Main Street East and Fourth Avenue

Main Street East and Fifth Avenue

- 3. No snowmobile shall be operated at a speed greater than 25 kilometers per hour within the limits of the Town of Langham.
- 4. It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 10:00 P. M.
- 5. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less that \$45.00 and costs.
- 6. This Bylaw shall come into force upon receipt of approval from the Highway Traffic Board.
