

**TOWN OF LANGHAM
BYLAW 2012-06**

**A BYLAW TO IMPOSE PENALTIES FOR THE BREACH OF THE
PROVISIONS OF ANY BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LANGHAM**

THE COUNCIL of the Town of Langham in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) This Bylaw shall be known and referred to as the “General Penalty Bylaw” of the Town of Langham.

- 2) Any person found guilty on summary conviction of a breach of any Bylaw of the Town of Langham for which no penalty is provided shall be liable to a fine of:
 - One Hundred dollars (\$100.) for the first offence;
 - Three Hundred dollars (\$300.) for the second offence; and
 - Five Hundred dollars (\$500.) for the third and each subsequent offence and Costs for each and every offence.

- 3) That Bylaw No. 3 – 85 hereby repealed.
