**Business Licenses:** 2022 Business Licenses have now expired. Please visit the town office to purchase your 2023 business license.

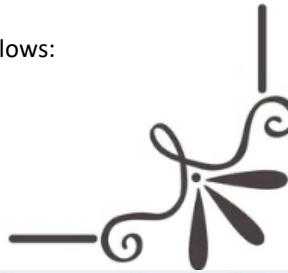

# *Langham Community Refugee Sponsorship Committee*

Please take the time to read this missive of the Langham Community Refugee Sponsorship Committee (LCRSC). We are using the tried and true W5 approach, Who, What, Where, When and Why with a slightly different twist.

## **WHAT?**

We formed the LCRSC in 2016 to help sponsor a refugee family. We are all volunteers from local churches, the community and environ. We welcome you to consider joining our team to make a difference to others.

## **WHO?**

In 2018 & 2019 we sponsored a Syrian family who settled in Saskatoon. Recently we learned of an Afghan family who have fled Afghanistan and are temporarily in Pakistan. A family member, Mustafa, who fled Afghanistan earlier, wants to bring his family to Saskatoon. He is established here and is able to share his home once they arrive. He needs our financial support as well as assistance in navigating the services and requirements of immigrants to our area.

## **WHERE?**

Saskatoon will become their new home. They will need furnishings, household supplies and living expenses for seven people.

## **WHEN?**

We need to raise \$25,000.00 by March 31<sup>st</sup> of this year in order to ensure our sponsoring agent we can support the refugee family after they arrive.

## **WHY?**

We know this is the right thing to do, to open our province, heart and purses to this family. We are all aware of the humanitarian and socially responsible need because of the political climate in Afghanistan. The LCRSC, with YOUR HELP will share with this family our Canadian freedoms, safe living conditions, and opportunities for their future, which is our country's future. Saskatchewan is known for its big hearted citizens. What you give will yield tenfold or more for this family!

This project is independent of any other projects or needs in Langham.
