Reminders from Town Office and Public Works

- ◆ All dogs and cats in the Town of Langham are required to be licensed. Licenses are \$45 for the lifetime of the animal. There is a \$5 replacement charge for a lost tag. Pets need to be leashed at all times on public property and please clean up after your pets.
- ◆ Reminder as per Bylaw 2019-04 vehicles parked on the street may only be parked for a maximum of 72 hours. Any vehicle parked for an uninterrupted period of time in excess of seventy-two (72) hours on any street may be ticketed, seized, removed and impounded at the expense of the owner thereof.
- ◆ Public Works will be out trimming trees along sidewalks and back alleys over the course of the next few weeks. If you have any questions or concerns please call the town office at 306-283-4842
- ◆ Thank you very much to the community for their patience with snow removal! Public Works has been hard at work keeping our streets and sidewalks clear and your understanding is very much appreciated.

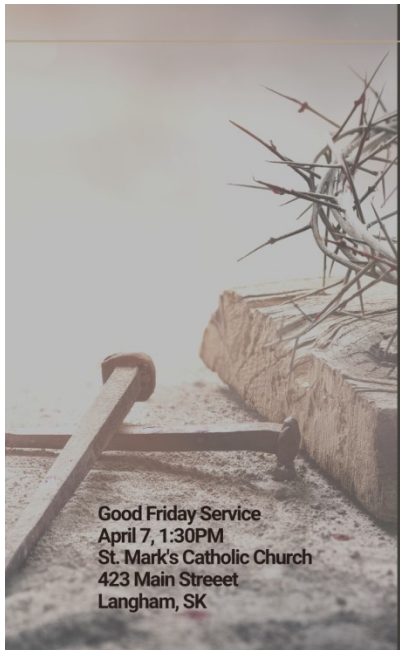
