Reminders from Town of Langham Public Works Department

Snow Removal

The Public works department would like to remind residents that in the event of a major snow fall please remove vehicles from the street in order for the crew to be able to adequately plow the roads.

Did you know that piling/pushing/blowing snow on our roadways and parking areas is in violation of our by-laws? Putting snow on our roadways is a risk to motorized vehicles as well as pedestrians.

Please pull your garbage/recycle/organic carts back onto your property as soon as possible on pick up days. Snow removal becomes nearly impossible to complete when the carts are left on the street.

Please watch for the “Tow Away Zone” signs.

Snowmobiles Within Town Limits

A reminder that it is unlawful to operate a snowmobile within Town Limits. All snowmobiles must take the most direct route to and from their residence to go in and out of town.

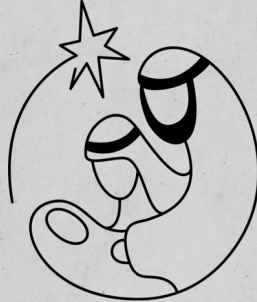
