Reminders from Town of Langham Public Works Department

Snow Removal

The Public works department would like to remind residents that in the event of a major snow fall please remove vehicles from the street in order for the crew to be able to adequately plow the roads.

The priority during large snowfall is to open the main streets as quickly and efficiently as possible. This means it may take longer to clear driveway openings and back alleys.

Did you know that piling/pushing/blowing snow on our roadways and parking areas is in violation of our bylaws? Putting snow on our roadways is a risk to motorized vehicles as well as pedestrians.

Please pull your garbage/recycle/organic carts back onto your property as soon as possible on pick up days. Snow removal becomes nearly impossible to complete when the carts are left on the street.

Please watch for the "Tow Away Zone" signs. These signs are used when our Public Works Department are planning to do snow removal from the boulevards.

Langham and District Heritage Village and Museum

Historic Canadian National Railway (CNR) Canadian Northern Railway (CNoR) station in Langham, Sask.

The old depot was built in 1905 for the Canadian Northern Railway (CNoR). It now houses the Langham and District Heritage Village and Museum and the Langham Branch Library.

The museum offers household and farm artifacts as well as items that tell the story of the area.

Special features of the museum include the "Peace Pole" outside the building, written in the diverse languages of the English, Norwegians, Doukhobor's, Mennonites, Hutterites, and Cree that live in the area.

The museum is also home to "Buttercup Betty"-a wooden milking cow used to demonstrate how milking by hand was done by early pioneers.
