Learn to Ski

The Learn-to-Ski clinics held in February were a huge success! We had over 40 participants with varied backgrounds, ages, and skills. Participants brought their families along to enjoy our ski space (and toboggan hill) for a whole-family day at the trails. Lessons included the basics of cross-country skiing, some practice time in our specially groomed class lanes, and then a guided tour on the Green Trail to the Lookout Point and back, about 1.9 km. It was so nice to see the positive interactions between skiers, families, community members, and volunteers. The Après-Ski van was just the cherry on top!

One of our goals this season is to start our own equipment rentals program. RRNSC Members would be able to rent ski equipment (skis, boots, poles) directly from the Club, with all proceeds staying in the Club for equipment maintenance and repairs. This venture would also include running Wax Clinics 2-3 times per season for those wishing to learn about ski maintenance, and weekly ski meetups.

programming! This grant has allowed youth and adults in Langham and area the opportunity to discover cross-country skiing at River Ridge Trails. Thank you so much for the opportunity to share our love of skiing with our community!
