PUBLIC NOTICE

The Town of Langham is notifying residents that Council is considering an increase to the waste collection fees for 2025. This adjustment is necessary due to increases in rates from Loraas Disposal, as outlined in Bylaw 2023-01, which ensures fees reflect contractor rate changes to achieve full cost recovery.

Why Are Fees Increasing? Loraas Disposal has informed the Town of the following rate increases for waste, recycling, and organics:

Service	2024 Rate	2025 Rate	\$ Increase	% Increase
Recycling	\$6.44	\$7.10	\$0.66	10.2%
Organic	\$6.20	\$7.10	\$0.90	14.5%
Waste	\$7.95	\$8.75	\$0.80	10.1%
Total Carts	\$20.59	\$22.95	\$2.36	11.5%


Additional costs include fuel surcharges and carbon taxes (currently \$3.63/month) and the admin fee (\$0.23/month).

Proposed 2025 Rate Council is proposing an increase to match the \$2.36/month cart cost increase, resulting in a new total rate of **\$26.80/month per property**. This increase will ensure fees remain aligned with contractor costs while minimizing additional financial impact on residents.

Next Steps

- Council has completed the first reading of Bylaw 2025-01.
- The second and third readings are expected to be completed prior to the February 1, 2025 billing cycle (for January billing).
