I want to congratulate the Town of Langham, its employees and residents on receiving recognition from Communities in Bloom. 2024 was our first year competing in the Competitive Category for the Town of Langham, and the judging was based on four key areas: Municipal Properties, Businesses & Institutions, Residential, and Community Involvement.

I'm pleased to announce that we earned three blooms out of a possible five! A huge thank you goes out to all the residents for the care they put into their properties, as well as to our town staff for their dedication and pride in maintaining our community. We are getting ready to attend the SUMA convention that is on from April 13 to 16, 2025. If you have a fire hydrant on your property, please make sure it is accessible. The fire department will appreciate it if they don't have to uncover a hydrant before they can pump for a fire.Please do not lay your extension cords across the sidewalk. The town bylaw says that extension cords need to be 3 metres above the sidewalk. If they are on the sidewalk when the sidewalk sweeper comes by, they may not see it and then we then have damage to equipment, or some-

one may trip over them.
