Mobile Vendor Businesses As per business license bylaw 2025-06

1. A license will not be issued for a mobile food vendor, until the applicant produces the following:
 - Approval from the Saskatoon Health District or Saskatchewan Health Authority
 - Fire inspection approval
 - Motor vehicle insurance (if mobile food truck or trailer)
 - Discharge Management Plans
 - Photographs of the unit/truck being used; and vi. Proof of liability insurance of \$2,000,000.
 - Confirmation that the mobile food vendor is equipped with a refuse container.
2. All equipment and signage associated with the mobile food vehicle/unit shall be located within 2.0m of the mobile food vehicle/unit.
3. All Mobile Food Vendors, regardless of type, must comply with the following operating requirements:
 - must be equipped with a refuse container
 - only a soft-toned bell or chime on each unit will be permitted
 - a Mobile Food Vending Unit may not be located or operated in areas designated as “No Parking” or “No Stopping”
 - a Mobile Food Vending Unit may not be located or operated in such a way as would restrict or interfere with the ingress or egress of adjacent property owners or restrict vehicular traffic on the street, intersections or crosswalks
 - a Mobile Food Vending Unit may not operate on a sidewalk or walking path, and
 - a Mobile Food Vending Unit shall not be operated on any street abutting school property on a school day between 8:00am and 4:00pm.
4. Location Restrictions Based on Vendor Type:
 - Food Trucks: SGI-registered, motorized vehicles; permitted to operate only where parking is legally permitted and only outside Residential Zoning Districts, in accordance with all other provisions of this Bylaw.
 - Food Trailers: SGI-registered, towed units; permitted on private property with permission.
 - Self-Propelled Carts: Manually operated; allowed temporarily in all zones and must be removed outside operating hours.
 - Seasonal Shacks/Kiosks: Semi-permanent structures; not mobile, must meet zoning/development permit requirements; public property use requires Council approval.
 - Event Services and Farmers Market Vendors: Subject to mobile vending provisions when operating from temporary structures or booths but otherwise permitted in public parks.
5. Use of public parks by mobile food trucks or trailers for special events, outside those organized by the Town, are subject to Council approval and may be restricted by location, duration, and conditions. Council may impose additional terms and conditions at its discretion, including but not limited to:
 - Specific hours or days of operation
 - Limits on the number of vendors per location
 - Requirements for waste management, signage, or maintenance
 - Restrictions based on community events, seasonal considerations, or public works.
