

Discussion on options for a tendering or RFP process are currently underway. The intent of the project is to ensure the town has adequate supply for the current population estimates and allow for future growth both residentially and commercially.

### Highway Commercial development

The detailed design draft has been received and approved by council.

# Council Corner

## Utility Rate Explainer

### Why are my rates going up?

There are a number of factors that go into rate increases; Inflation which effects the cost of utilities, consumable supplies, even things like maintenance costs. Wage increases and increased part costs all play a factor.

### What is this actually paying for?

There are a number of things which capital from this revenue is used for some of the primary items include:

#### Sewer:

- Engineering fees as part in the CHIF Application.
- Sewer Main Flushing.
- The implementation of the sewer lateral repair program.
- Power/Energy for the lift stations.
- Legal expenses for capital project.
- Ongoing Lagoon Debenture payments.

#### Water:

- Water Treatment Chemicals.
- Water Treatment Plant Repairs.
- Power/Energy.
- Water Main Break Repairs.

Additionally capital raises for the ongoing water treatment plant upgrades to reduce the amount of debt required by the town to complete the project.
